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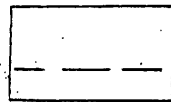
SCHEDULE III

**FINENESS MARK SURROUNDS IN MANUFACTURERS' OR SPONSORS'
HALLMARKS AUTHORISED BY THE CONSUL**

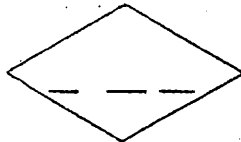
1. The surround specific to each precious metal referred to in paragraph (c) of regulation 6 and which must surround the standards of fineness of the precious metals referred to in Schedule II are indicated below:-



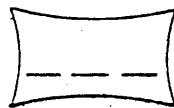
Gold



Silver



Platinum



Palladium

2. The standard of fineness must be indicated within these surrounds along the axis of the dashes.
3. The imprint of these surrounds must be immediately preceded by an adjacent appropriate manufacturer's or sponsor's mark set in an independent surround.
